

CSI Counselors' Bookshelf Contest

You are invited to help celebrate the new Counselors' Bookshelf! The Bookshelf is a clearinghouse for CSI members to locate book and media resources recommended by other CSI members.

Have you read a good book or seen a good movie or television show lately? Has this book or movie helped you become a better counselor? Have you listened to a great CD or Podcast? This book, movie, CD, or other resource could be about an area of counselor training or practice, a particular life situation, developmental issue, or client issues. It could be in one of four areas:

Professional Books

Any "academic" books related to counseling

Books That Helped Me Become a Better Counselor

Fiction or non-fiction books about clients, issues, developmental needs, etc.

Bibliotherapy Resources

Fiction, children's books, movie clips, poetry, painting, activities that can be used in creative arts counseling

Movies and TV Shows

Movies and TV shows that help us learn about life, counselors, and counseling issues

Share your resources and reactions with other professional counselors by filling out the on-line Book Review form. Reviews are 250 words except for the Professional Books section. Those can be 500 words.



To submit, visit the CSI website, www.csi-net.org, click on "Counselors' Bookshelf", then follow the instructions.

How to Enter: Submissions will be accepted from April 1 through August 30th, 2009. Each time you submit an accepted entry, your name will be entered in one of four drawings. One drawing will be held for each area of the Bookshelf, and 3 winners in each area will received a \$50 gift certificate to the CSI Store. Drawings will be held and winners notified in September.
